May 3, 2019—The Urban Partnership Drug Free Community Coalition (UPDFCC) hosted a Youth Community Townhall. GA's pillar of service highlighted in this event is Community Upliftment and Partnerships. UPDFCC is a community coalition with a priority of reducing underage drinking and marijuana use. Panelist informed about underage drinking in youth were invited to sit on the panel to answer questions and have discussions with youth concerning serious underage drinking and substance use. The invited panelist included; Tamara I. Gray – Assistant Public Defender; Steve Williams – Case and Court Services Coordinator at Here's Help; Officer Pierre Jean-Gilles – Miami Police Department; and Tania Andre – Founding President of The Mavuno Project.



Panelist were asked questions by the Youth Frontliner's and audience members consisting of both youth and adults.
