

# Terms of Reference Healthy Relationship/Sexual Risk Avoidance Education Program Evaluation Consultant

## **Background:**

Gang Alternative, Inc. (GA)'s Sexual Risk Avoidance Education programs (SRAE) educates youth on how to abstain from nonmarital sexual activity by enhancing protective factors to reduce sexual risk behaviors among minority teenagers living in Broward County and Palm Beach County, utilizing a descriptive study to evaluate program efficacy.

# **Responsibilities:**

- Analyze entry and exit survey data for program cohorts
- Assist with development of focus group discussion questionnaire
- Analyze participant focus group responses
- Analyze participant attendance data
- Facilitate focus groups (virtual or in-person)

#### **Deliverables:**

- Data analysis report to include the following:
  - o Entry and exit survey findings
  - o Analysis of qualitative data collected in focus group discussions
  - o Analysis of attendance data

### **Qualifications:**

- A Master's degree or higher in a relevant field such as Social Sciences, Public Administration, Education, Evaluation, or Data Analytics.
- Proven experience in program evaluation, including the design and implementation of surveys and focus groups.
